Hop-On Hop-Off Bus: 48 hrs-\$ 55

Experience the Greek capital on a hop-on hop-off sightseeing tour along 3 different routes. You'll travel on an open-top, double-decker bus as you take in the many important sights and attractions of the city. You can visit world-renowned museums and marvel at the ancient temples - the Acropolis and Parthenon.

Acropolis, Parthenon & Acropolis Museum Guided Tour: Daily, AM & PM \$ 123

Meet your tour guide and enter from the south slope of the Acropolis and set off on your walking tour of some of the world's finest monuments. Along the way, listen as your guide shares insight into the citadel's ruins. Visit the Theater of Dionysus, an amphitheater that is arguably the birthplace of performing arts. Perch yourself on a stone seat to imagine the experience by ancient theatergoers who came to watch plays by Greek writers like Sophocles and Euripides. Pass the Odeon of Herodes Atticus; the theater is still used today during the Athens Festival. Find peace and quiet at an Asclepius, a healing temple that honored the god of medicine.



Athens Walking Tour: Daily, AM \$ 72

With a history that spans over 3,400 years, Athens is one of the oldest cities in the world. This walking tour takes you through Athens' rich history and multifaceted culture, surprising and enchanting you around every street corner. As you stroll through Athens' primeval streets, learn from your guide about the complex history of the ancient city.

Old Town Highlights Electric Bike Tour: Daily AM, PM \$ 69

Cycle the historic center of Athens on a 9-kilometer bike tour and see archaeological and architectural highlights of the city such as the Panathenaic Stadium, Presidential Mansion, indoor exhibition center of the Zappeion Hall, and Roman Agora. Discover the city's green spaces, such as the National Gardens. Explore historic neighborhoods, such as Plaka, in the footsteps of the Acropolis. Go to the ancient burial site of Kerameikos Cemetery. Admire the dome of the National Observatory of Athens and enter the traditional neighborhood of Thission. (Option with Acropolis Available)

Catamaran Cruise with Light Lunch and Wine: Daily AM, PM \$ 184

Enjoy one of Europe's best coastlines aboard a sailing Catamaran with a professional crew of 2 ready to show you some of the best spots Athens Riviera can offer, while sipping a drink and tasting some freshly made Greek meze. Your first swim stop is off Hydroussa uninhabited islet accessible only by sea, here you can enjoy its azure-colored waters. Next set sail at Vouliagmeni Bay,. Your hostess will prepare a freshly made Greek light lunch to be served in a pristine environment while you get back onboard from exploring the rocky coast.

Explore Meteora with a Guided Bus Tour: Daily, AM \$ 69

Explore the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Meteora on a guided tour by bus from Athens. Learn about the history, architecture, and spirituality of Meteora's monasteries from your guide. Hop aboard a comfortable vehicle and make a short stop before the tour starts for lunch (not included in the price). Begin your tour of Meteora and all six of its active monasteries. Explore the interiors of three of them with this unique opportunity.

Street Food Tasting Tour: Daily, PM \$ 72

Kick-off your foodie adventure at a pie shop to taste traditional cheese pie or spanakopita made right on spot with the freshest ingredients. Discover why Greeks are crazy about souvlaki and enjoy it with local beer or wine. Enjoy meat (or vegetables) wrapped in pita bread, juicy tomatoes, and tzatziki sauce at a local joint away from the crowds.



Full Day Delphi Tour: \$ 105

Explore the most famous sights of ancient Greece on a full-day guided mythology-inspired tour. Ignite your imagination with mythical tales of the culture and history of Delphi. Learn about the Oracle, ancient ruins like the amphitheater, and the Temple of Apollo, and immerse yourself in local history. Depart from Athens and travel to Delphi, located on the spur of Mount Parnassus. On your way, admire the Greek countryside and the mountain views.
