Nice Hop-On and Off Panoramic Bus Tour: Daily, 24 hrs.-\$ 35 48 hrs, \$ 40

Your pass for the hop on, hop off sightseeing tour of Nice ensures a comfortable and convenient way to see the city at your own pace from the open-top deck of the bus. The on-board audio guide describes top things to see and places to visit in Nice. The day pass is valid for unlimited sightseeing on the tour route, meaning that you can hop on and hop off the coach at any of the stops along the way.

Highlights of Nice: \$ 62

Spend some time seeing the sights of Nice, the glamorous capital of the French Riviera. Tour includes La Promenade des Anglais, the Russian church, Monastery, the Arena, the Old Town known as Vieux Nice and soaks up the atmosphere at the flower and flea markets.



Grand Tour by Segway: \$ 84

See the sights of Nice by Segway on this 2-hour guided tour that explores the architecture, cultural heritage, history, and unique landscapes of the French Riviera city. Cruise along the Promenade des Anglais, enjoy panoramic views from Castle Hill, and glide through the baroque streets of the Old Town. Take in the breathtaking views from the curving coastline from the Rauba Capeu observation point.

Half Day Cannes, Antibes, St. Paul de Vence: Daily, \$ 130

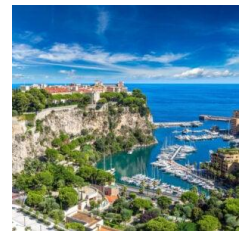
Take a drive along the stunning coastal road to Antibes. Head to the Old Town where Picasso lived, visit the beautiful harbor and see the ramparts built by Vauban. Continue to the glamorous city of Cannes, you'll travel down the Promenade de la Croisette and see the luxury hotels that have hosted celebrities from Marilyn Monroe to Scarlett Johansson. Stop at the renowned Cannes Film Festival Palace and walk in the steps of the stars. Visit the medieval village of Saint-Paul-de-Vence, made famous by the actors and artists that lived here, including such greats as Bonnard, Braque, Dufy, and Matisse. Stroll along the cobblestone streets, stop in at the galleries, and take in spectacular views of the sea.

Half Day Monaco & Eze Village: Daily, \$ 75

Explore the best of the Cote d'Azur on a half-day sightseeing tour from Nice. Enjoy the panoramic view from Villefranche over Cap Ferrat, the Bay of Billionaires and its famous villas. Drive along the Lower Corniche to the Old Town of Monaco. With free time to visit the Palace, the Cathedral, stunning gardens and see the changing of the Palace Guards. Tour of the Principality following the amazing Formula 1 Grand Prix circuit! Stop at Monte-Carlo and its luxurious casino, mega yachts, chic boutiques. Return by Middle Corniche road and visit of the charming medieval village of Eze.

Full Day Monaco, Montecarlo, Eze Tour: Daily \$ 89

Enjoy the panoramic view over Nice from Mt. Boron. Next, on the Middle Corniche stop at Eze, a medieval perched village with breathtaking panorama. Take a guided tour of a traditional perfumery to discover the true essence of Provence. Visit the Old Town of Monaco, the famous 'Rock'. Tour Monte-Carlo and drive along the amazing Grand Prix circuit. Then enjoy some free time at Casino Square. Do some shopping, stroll along the stunning gardens, view the mega-yachts, and chic casino. Then drive along the spectacular coastline of the Lower Corniche between Nice and Monaco. See the typical Mediterranean villages and modern marinas. Admire the Bay and Citadel of Villefranche.



Full Day St. Tropez & Port Grimaud: Wed, Sun \$ 175

Head to Saint Tropez; once a sleepy fisherman's village, it's now the summer playground for Europe's glitziest stars. See the mega yachts of the elite and stroll the cobbled streets of Saint Tropez while learning about the history and culture of the town. There will be free time for lunch too. On this full-day small-group tour, you'll also get to visit Port Grimaud just a few kilometers down the coast. A Mediterranean yachting and fishing village on the North shore of St Tropez's Bay, it's easy to see why Port Grimaud is famous for its tiny bridges, squares, and canals. Marvel at its charming villas the color of a Riviera sunset!
